<p>On Section VII. Technical Specifications</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Soil Poisoning - Twice a year <p>Proposing that soil poisoning be done only once a year instead of twice. Can you confirm if this change is acceptable?</p>	<p>Adhere to the requirements outlined in the Terms of Reference.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chemical Dusting – Quarterly <p>Chemical dusting is not permitted under FDA regulations, and we are unable to provide an FDA Certificate of Product Registration for it. We propose using liquid termiticide as an alternative. Can you confirm if this change is acceptable?</p>	<p>There are other methods of treatment; spraying and dusting are specified in the Terms of Reference. If dusting is not allowed by the FDA as per FDA Advisory No. 2022-0699 & 2021-0499, then spraying may be used instead.</p>

How should we address this for compliance?</p>	<p>Adhere to requirements stated in the Terms of Reference that the service provider should have at least a tie-up with any animal shelter, whether private or public, with a corresponding Memorandum of Agreement (MOA). The specifics or provisions under the MOA should be conformed to by both the service provider and the animal shelter.</p>
<p>e. License (current and valid) as Pest Control Operator from Fertilizer and Pesticide Authority (FPA)</p> <p>f. Current and Valid Certificate Pesticide Applicators (CPA's) Accreditation ID</p> <p>Clarification on the requirement for a Licensed FPA Pest Control Exterminator/Operator with an FPA Pesticide Applicator ID. Since FDA Circular 2022-010 and Advisory No. 2024-0749 now regulate</p>	<p>Adhere to FDA Circular 2022-010, which states that the application and approval of the license are now under the FDA, not the FPA.</p>

- A. Bid Security shall be 120 calendar days from the date of submission and opening of bids.
- B. Section VII: Technical Specifications - Please write "COMPLY" to indicate that requirements are met.
- C. Eligibility requirements and technical proposal should be in one folder and financial proposal in a separate folder, with shoelace on top instead of fastener, table of contents and index tabs in words, not numbers.
- D. Folder of Eligibility requirements and technical proposal should be placed in one envelope. And folder of Financial proposal should be in another envelope. Both envelopes shall then be placed in one mother envelope marked as "**Original Bid**"
- E. Documents should be arranged chronologically according to the checklist issued.
- F. Color code for folders and envelope:

- G. All other provisions on the bidding documents which are not affected shall remain in effect.
- H. Prospective bidders must send a request in conducting Site Survey.

- J. The BAC shall open the bids immediately after the deadline for submission and receipt of bids.
